ENROLLMENT INFORMATION: Grade level is determined by the grade the student will enter in September 2009. Registration will be on a first-come, first-served basis, beginning April 6, 2009. *Classes are offered subject to enrollment* and are limited to 20-25 students. Confirmation of classes will be sent to the student's home address. Enrollment continues as long as space is available. NOTE: Unless enrolled, children may not visit classes as a guest.

FEES: Tuition per child is \$395. Some classes have a materials fee in addition to the tuition that is non-refundable and non-transferable. **ALL FEES MUST BE PAID BY JUNE 12th.** Make check payable to: Santa Monica-Malibu Council of PTAs. Fees paid after June 19th must be in cash, check or money order. *No student will be allowed to attend class without full payment.* Bank returned checks are subject to a \$25 fee and will disqualify the student from the program until a cash payment is received. **TUITION REFUND POLICY:** Full refund less \$25 handling fee if cancellation is received before June 12; June 13-19, 50% refund of total fees due, less \$25 handling fee; no refunds after June 20. Credit card service fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.

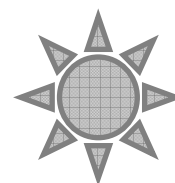

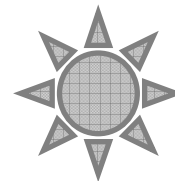
